

Boot Scootin Boogie

Beginner - advanced – 9 hours

This is a fun collage and applique class but also a class for alternative means of quilting using decorative stitching – either free motion or with decorative stitching on machine – or a mixture of both = Learn to use your decorative stitching to create texture on your fabric. Different style boot patterns will be available.

Class Supply

1 fat quarter light – medium brown – may have color variations – but no print. 1 - 3” x 18” Drk brown or black

1 - 4x4” other Drk Brown or Darker Black square 1/3 – 1/2 yard flower fabric or mixtures of flower fabrics. Flowers should be easy to identify (not watercolor) Flowers should be about 2 – 3” each, no small flowers. Suggestions – poinsettias, daisies, sunflowers, roses, tulips, Chrysanthemum, - **Iron heat and Bond to back of fabric and fussy cut out the flowers. Cut leaves as well if your fabric has leaves on them. This must be done prior to class.** Scraps of green that coordinate with flowers. Iron heat and bond to back. 20 x 24” white or off white – may be white on white - No strong pattern 20x24” batting – warm and soft, bamboo or bamboo blend – low loft nothing fluffy 20x24” white for backing.

1 yard heat and bond lite – **NO STEAM A SEAM.**

Thread

prewound white bobbin
white thread – 40 or 50 weight
med and dk brown thread. 40 – 50 weight
a thread that blends with your flower choices.

Regular sewing foot

Open toe embroidery foot or hopping foot.

small sharp scissors,

fabric marking pen, sm tip sharpie or sharp pencil

Optional but helpful - 12 x 12 or larger wool ironing mat
