

Featherweight Troubleshooting and Maintenance

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Purpose: This class is made to give every Featherweight owner the confidence to care for their own machine without needing yearly visits to your service technician. On top of that it will give you the knowledge to fix minor issues as they may arise at future retreats or when sewing alone.

Description: In this class we will touch on the history of the Featherweight to start off. Next we will be going over the regular issues that arise from using our vintage machines as we move from inside to out oiling, greasing, and cleaning everything. As we go along if you need new bed cushions, belt, lightbulb, controller feet, or drip pan we'll have them available for purchase or if you've already brought replacements, we'll show you how to get everything changed and installed as necessary. Though we can't cover everything, and won't have time to deep clean rusty machines, we'll still give you the confidence to take care of those minor problems that come up from time to time and keep your machine running smooth.

Requirements: Featherweight, foot controller/cord, thread, scrap fabric, bobbin, bobbin case, and snips.
