

Cathedral Windows Supply List

The small quilt we will make in class will just be to learn the technique. It will measure approximately 16" by 16" when we finish and will be great to use for a pillow front.

You will need:

16 - 9 ½ in squares of background fabric (All the same or a variety of similar tones)

16 – 2 ½ in squares of accent (All the same or different – your choice – my sample is made with a variety of blues. You could select a favorite holiday and make a pillow.)

Sewing machine with thread to match your background

Applique' thread to match your background

Applique' Needle (Please bring a needle that you prefer – we can discuss different ones in class)

Thimble - if you like

Basic sewing supplies (scissors, pins, seam ripper)

A chop stick or knitting needle to use to turn the "pockets"

Applique' pins

Safety pins

Irons will be provided during class but are an essential part of the creation of this quilt.

The quilt that is displayed measures 78.5" x 87.5" and requires 22 ½ yards of background fabric and 4 ½ yards of insets cut into 2 ½" squares. 😊 There is no batting used in the quilt.

I will be teaching you how to finish off the small quilt and make a pillow or how to make this project quite large and turn it into a take along project!
