

EPP (English Paper Piecing) - (12 hours)

From simple projects to elaborate quilts, this hand piecing method is a favorite. Just a few small pieces of fabric, templates, needle and thread and you're off.

We'll discover some tips and tricks to this old method, while learning' relaxing and having a stress free and fun time (You will soon be hooked). This is the best take along project ever.

The featured photos is an English Paper Piecing Kit for the class with 2 basic shapes.

The kit contains all the papers, pattern and acrylic templates for this project. It is possible you will be able to finish the shapes and start to appliquéd it to a background if that is what you would like to do. This is a fun workshop for beginners as well as experienced English Paper Piecers.

In addition other shapes will be explored and you will be able to choose other shapes to try. We'll stitch up some hexagons, diamonds and curves as well. Designing with different shapes will be explored as well. If you are interested in a specific shape please let me know and I can try to accommodate your needs. More information coming if you sign up for the workshop.

I will also bring thread, needles and some other notions to use during class.

No machine required.

Supplies:

Thread, needles, rotary cutting supplies, scissors. Colored pencils (optional) to help with design.

Glue stick (Sewline or Fons and Porter)

Wonder -clips (1 or 2)

Fabric:

An assortment of fabric will give you the most options, fat eights, scraps (at least 5 inches) will work well. I suggest at least 8 fabrics. A 5" square such as a charm pack is adequate for most of the shapes.

If you want to start to appliquéd your design a 12" x 12" fabric square will also be needed. For the super achievers you may want to bring batting and backing as well. It's up tp you.
