Supplies Needed

Willingness to try again

Your existing unfinished project

Paper piecing tools: 12” or 18” add-a-quarter ruler, 3” x 18” piece of template plastic, repositionable glue stick or school glue stick, fabric glue pen (such as Fons & Porter, Quilter’s Select, etc.), large paper clips, gallon size ziploc bags, Acorn precision piecing solution. All of these items can also be purchased from me – let me know when you are ordering your pattern which items you will need and I will package it up and bring to the workshop with me!

Basic Sewing supplies: #70 sewing machine needle, sewing machine, seam ripper, thread, scissors, rotary cutter and mat, etc.

Class length: .5 day
