

Hare-e-etta

Using up those scraps with quilting artist Karen Wallach

Supply List

- 2 Yards Muslin
- Fabric scraps quilting cotton or upholstery fabrics for body of hare
Helpful hints for what to bring (Choose **one** idea no need to bring your whole stash)
 1. Choose a color pull two light, three mediums, and two dark in that color way
 2. Choose a fabric designer Kaffe Fassett or Tulla Pink use their fabrics to create your hare
 3. Choose a theme Garden Hare, Seasonal Hare like Christmas or Easter or get creative and pull fabrics to tell your story
- Items to embellish with buttons, ribbons, lace items with different textures example fake fur, burlap
- 2 Large buttons for eyes one inch in size
- 2 x-Large buttons for leg joints 1½ or larger
- Contrasting threads for decorative stitching 2-3 colors DMC embroidery cotton threads, variegated or solid colors pearl cotton or six strand
- Embroidery and hand sewing needles if you own a 10” doll making needle please bring. Will have a few doll making needles to use in class these needles can be hard to find and can be expensive for just one time use I will have 10” needles to share this needle is only used to sew on hind legs
- Curved sewing needle
- Large bag of doll or teddy bear stuffing
- Wire cutters
- Paper scissors
- 1” Masking tape
- Two empty paper towel rolls
- Basic sewing kit with fabric sheers
- Optional: small cutting mat, ruler, and rotary cutter most of this project can be cut with fabric sheers but a rotary cutter can be fun to work with. Will demo curved piecing techniques with rotary cutter
- Sewing machine in good working order
