Circular Logic

Using a traditional drunkards path template, students will create their own path utilizing improvisational piecing methods to make a series of modern blocks that might stand alone or be joined together in a quilt. Skills to be honed include cutting fabrics using templates, strip piecing, and piecing curves with minimal pinning. In addition to quarter circle blocks, students may wish to explore elongated and elliptical shapes to create an even more modern look. If you've been apprehensive about piecing curves, fear no more. This class will put some FUN in the fundamentals.

Supplies Needed:

Sewing machine with quarter inch foot if possible

Thread

Rotary cutter and cutting mat

Scissors

Thread

Square Ruler at least 8 ½ inch

Ruler to cut strips – 12" long enough

Variety of fabrics that mix and match well (10" squares work well for these 8 ½ inch blocks). You may wish to add some bold B&W fabrics and stripes for impact

Planned class length: 6-9 hours
