Class Supplies:

- Book: "Walk: Master Machine Quilting with Your Walking Foot" by Jacquie Gering
- Sewing machine in good working order with walking foot, power cord, foot pedal, manual with instructions for attaching walking foot if needed, walking foot guide bar if available
- Extension table for your sewing machine if available
- Ten prepared 10" quilt sandwiches (solid color top fabric, thin cotton batting and backing fabric), pressed, starched and SPRAY BASTED prior to class
- Thread to contrast with quilt sandwiches
- Several fully wound bobbins
- New sewing machine needle
- Basic Sewing Supplies
- Blue or green painters tape (1" width recommended)
- Ruler at least 18" in length
- Sewing gauge similar to those pictured
- Fabric marking tool of choice
- Quilting gloves if desired
